The common term thirteen original colonies is misleading as Britain ruled thirty-two colonies in North America, including the Caribbean Islands by 1775 but only thirteen of them staked a rebellion. Of the 2.5 million people, about half a million were black and white immigrants made up nearly 400,000 of the increased number, and black "forced immigrants" accounted for almost as many again.
