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### Similar Triangles Study Guide

Figure 2 Similar triangles.  $m\angle 1 = m\angle 2$ , because vertical angles are equal.  $m\angle R = m\angle T$  or  $m\angle Q = m\angle U$ , because if two parallel lines are cut by a transversal, then the alternate interior angles are equal. So by the AA Similarity Postulate,  $\triangle QRS \sim \triangle UTS$ . Example 3: Use Figure 3 to show that  $\triangle MNO \sim \triangle PQR$ . Figure 3 Similar triangles. In  $\triangle MNO$ ,  $MN = NO$ , and in  $\triangle PQR$ ,  $PQ = QR$ .

When two triangles are similar, the reduced ratio of any two corresponding sides is called the scale factor of the similar triangles. In Figure 1,  $\triangle ABC \sim \triangle DEF$ . Figure 1 Similar triangles whose scale factor is 2 : 1. The ratios of corresponding sides are 6/3, 8/4, 10/5.

Are they similar? In the first triangle, we know  $\angle P = 48^\circ$  and  $\angle I = 79^\circ$ . Since  $m\angle P + m\angle I + m\angle T = 180$ , we can calculate that  $m\angle T = 53^\circ$ . In the second triangle,  $m\angle L = 48^\circ$  and  $m\angle A = 79^\circ$ . Again, since  $m\angle L + m\angle A + m\angle D = 180$ , we know that  $\angle D$  must be  $53^\circ$  as well. Both triangles have three congruent angles, which means they must be similar.
