In more general terms, this supply chain represents any non-coordinated system where problems arise due to lack of systemic thinking.

The simulation is run as a board game in teams playing the roles of retailers, wholesalers, distributors, and brewers of beer. As the backlog for orders increase, players order too much inventory, forcing their teammates into severe backlogs further down the supply chain. The game can be emotionally intense.
